(to be placed on foreign assembler's letterhead)

I, **(A)**, declare that to the best of my knowledge and belief the **(B)** was assembled in whole or in part from fabricated components listed and described below, which are products of the United States.

Explanation of Assembler's Declaration

This declaration is to accompany each Commercial Invoice that has commodity that qualifies for the special duty savings program. It is to be put on the foreign supplier's letterhead and signed.

- A. Non-US supplier's employee that is signing the declaration.
- B. Imported Item

Articles Assembled abroad with US Components and the final assembly is imported into the U.S. (9802.00.80)

- ❖ **This provision allows duty free entry of US fabricated components that are returned to the United States as part of articles assembled abroad.**
- ❖ **Definition of assembly operations performed abroad consist of any of the methods used to join or fit together solid components, such as welding, soldering, riveting, force fitting, gluing, laminating, sewing or the use of fasteners.**
- ❖ **Fabricated components are manufactured articles **READY** for assembly in the condition as exported except for operations incidental to the assembly.**
- ❖ **US made fabricated components **CAN NOT** be further processed abroad in any way to qualify for this provision. IE machining, polishing, peening**
- ❖ **Assembler's Declaration must be on assembler's letterhead and accompany the commercial invoice.**
 - ❖ **It contains a list of US components & their fair market value at time of export to foreign supplier for assembly. (Manufacturer's affidavit for these US components covered in the 9802 claim must be on file with the importer of record).**
 - ❖ **Assembly description**
- ❖ **Importer's Declaration for Assembled Articles needs to be completed by the party responsible for importing the final assembled part into the United States.**
