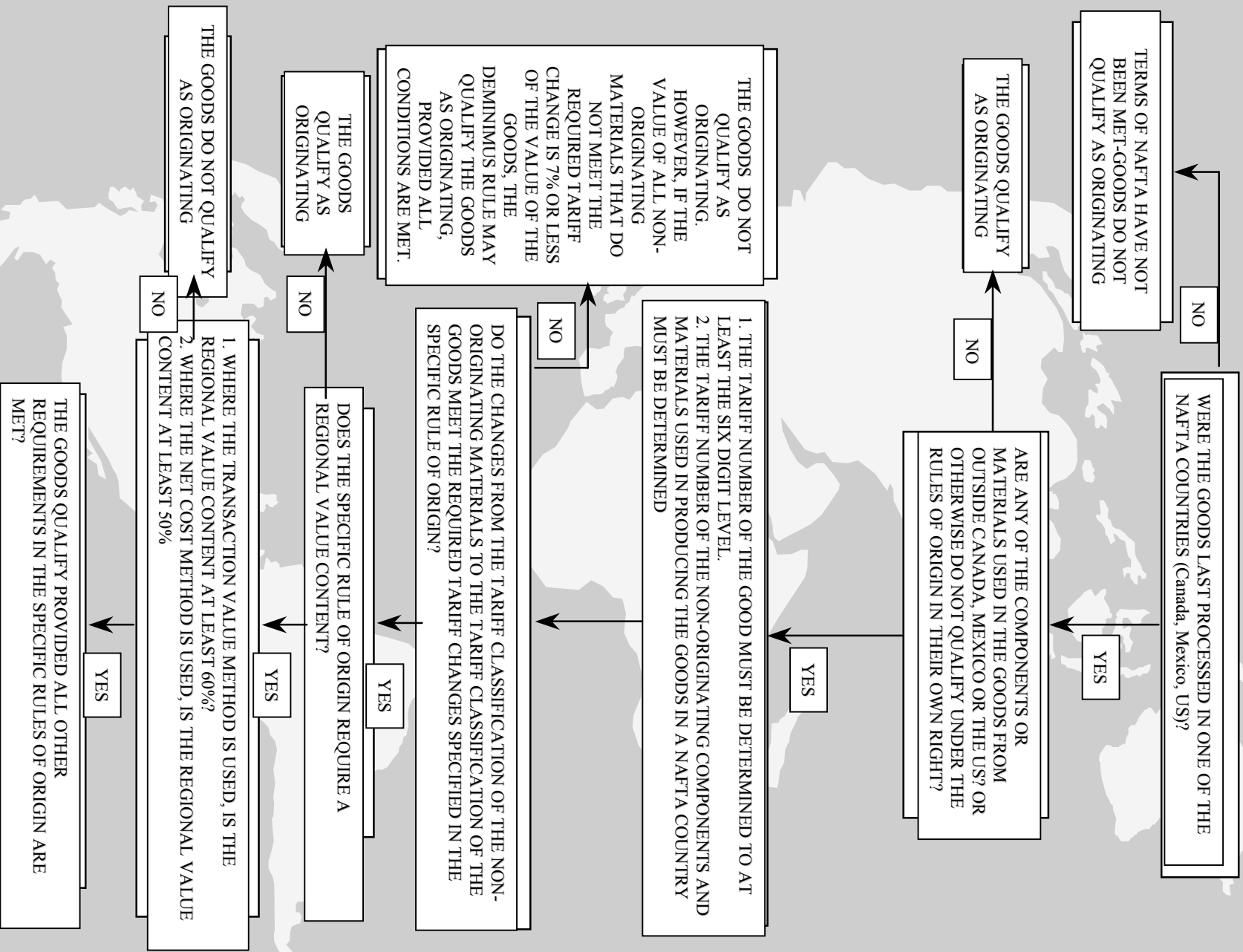

NAFTA

(North American Free Trade Agreement)

- ◆ **Provides duty free or reduced duty treatment for goods that originate within a NAFTA Country (US, Canada, Mexico)**
 - ◆ **Must meet all rules of origin**
- ◆ **Suppliers NEED to provide a NAFTA Certificate of Origin for all NAFTA eligible products.**
- ◆ **NAFTA Certificate must accompany shipping documentation OR blanket Certification must be on file with GEE Customs Compliance group at time of importation.**
 - ☞ **All fields must be complete and accurate**
