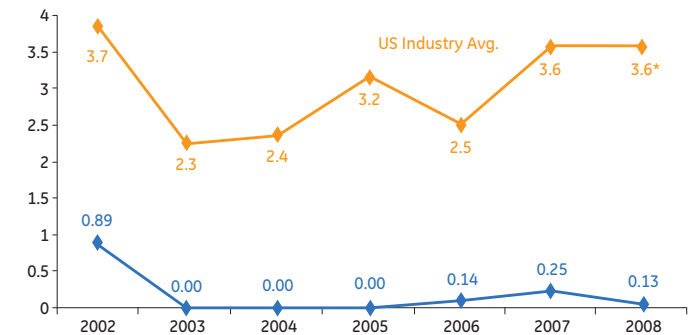
### Our Dedication
